## Curriculum Overview

**Accredited agricultural training and practical, work integrated learning opportunities combined with a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE).**

This provides a solid foundation for our graduates in terms of employment and education opportunities with flexibility and diversity in career pathways.

### Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE)

QATC Access Ag students are supported and supervised as they work towards their QCE, studying core subjects – Math and English – and the Agricultural Practices subject via the Capricornia School of Distance Education.



### Vocational qualifications in Agriculture

- » AHC20116 Certificate II in Agriculture
- » AHC30116 Certificate III in Agriculture

Students apply their school learning in a practical environment, becoming work-ready sooner and well placed to move into further vocational or tertiary studies.



### CQUniversity Start Uni Now (SUN) units

Start Uni Now (SUN) is a CQUniversity initiative that allows students in Year 11 and 12 to study subsidised CQUniversity units while still in high school.



### Work integrated learning

Students undertaking the QATC Access Ag program have the benefit of work integrated learning during each year of study, on college properties and with our industry partners. Students in this program participate in industry relevant research projects delivered on our industry-scale enterprises, where it is normal for your practical experience to occur.

Work integrated learning gives students the opportunity to apply their skills across a variety of real world situations, improve their workplace communication skills, and make a great impression on potential future employers.

### Entry requirements

Students must have completed Year 10.

### Delivery

- » Face-to-face.
- » Full-time on-campus program based at Emerald Agricultural College. During the program students also undertake training across other locations to experience a variety of production systems.

### Course fees

The vocational education and training (VET) fee component is funded by the Queensland Government Certificate III Guarantee program, subject to student eligibility for funding.
